# Course Overview

Dr. Sam will be introducing the General Practitioners to full arch implant rehabilitation with immediate loading -All on X- with emphasis on the extremely atrophic maxillae and the use of Pterygoids, Zygomatic and Transnasal implants. This course will review basic to advanced implant concepts. Participants will learn case presentation, treatment planning strategies and observe recorded surgeries from a world class clinical expert in full arch implants using remote anchorage and site specific dental implants. Emphasis will be on clinical ways of rehabilitating traditional and the severely atrophic maxillae with immediate loading protocols as well as advanced prosthetic digital workflow for the surgical and final processes.
