All-on-X and Immediate Load with Conventional and Extramaxillary Techniques Full Arch Rehabilitation

Overview

Explore innovative techniques in All-on-X dental implantology, focusing on zygomatic and pterygoid implant placement and restoration. Discover how zygomatic implants have revolutionized treatment for challenging cases, providing hope to patients previously deemed untreatable. Learn about quad-zygoma formation for cases with inadequate bone in maxillary zones 1-3, and explore alternative anchorage sites for patients with complex anatomies or implant failures. Delve into the concept of multicortical anchorage using a "transnasal" approach, leveraging paranasal bone for successful implant placement.
